1. Describe your project and its purpose (approximately 200 words)?

UBCC350 is planning on holding a Movie Night on September 24th, as a welcome to new members and an invitation for collaboration with other environmental groups on campus. We think that with so many environmental groups on campus, who all have the same end goal, we should be working together particularly before the election. At this event, we hope to have representatives from several groups on campus attend so we can formally invite them to our Vancouver-Quadra Candidate's Climate Debate, held in October. At the Debate, attendees will be listening to candidates address environmental policy, to see which major political party aligns with how they want to see climate change addressed in their government.

Your funding would be used for providing food and strategizing materials. Snacks and coffee/tea would be provided during the movie,

and we will also need money for brainstorming materials to see what each group wants discussed at the debate and how they want to be represented.

2. Outline how your project pertains to the environment and sustainability at UBC (approximately 200 words)?

One of UBCC350's main goals in the upcoming months is to get students to not only vote in the upcoming election, but to vote for the climate. It is a difficult task to reach out to 60,000 students, and so we want to work with other environmental groups on campus to encourage students to vote. We will discuss what they would like to see our Debate event, see if any of them want to give presentations in addition to the speeches several professors will be giving about climate and policy, ask these groups to participate in the interactive portion of the Debate and more. Brainstorming about getting students to vote and vote for the environment is the main priority. The movie we show will also have an environmental/political theme (most likely Directly Affected). Our food will all be sustainably sourced, and we will likely be purchasing from Sprouts as we have done for our previous events.

If any further explanation is needed, we would be happy to have a representative come to one of your meetings and explain things further!
