Along with fundraising for UBC CLF and HSF, we also hope to promote sustainability at this event. To do this, we are hoping to only serve organic and sustainable snacks and drinks at this event, along with using biodegradable plates to reduce waste.

The snacks we are planning to have at the event includes organic pies from Aphrodites (work with local farms to ensure smallest ecological footprint), locally grown fruits and veggies, along with natural and organic chips and snacks. The fruits, vegetables and snacks will all be purchased from Greens Organic and Natural Market, a store that strives for “limiting [the] impact on the environment by buying locally, composting and recycling. In fact, [they’re] one of the first grocery stores to take on Metro Vancouver’s Zero waste challenge.”

How to Submit the Funding Application

Completed forms can be emailed to sec.ubc@gmail.com (preferred) or dropped off at our office, Room 2106 of in the AMS Student Nest, during office hours¹. You are also welcome (but not required) to attend our weekly meetings² to present your project idea to our group, though we would appreciate an email informing us of this intent at least 48 hours ahead of time. The executive team and other active members of SEC would be happy to help you formulate your project as well as assist with its development and applications for funding.

If your funding application is approved, the Student Environment Centre will reimburse you for the specified purchases and expenses. You will then be referred to our Treasurer, whom you must provide with receipts and/or proof-of-purchases. Reimbursement usually takes about 5 business days. In the event that a student is unable to make the necessary purchase(s) to start their project, arrangements for advance funding can be made.

A Note about Eco-Initiatives Grants

Eco-Initiatives Grants can be used to fund a wide variety of projects: any projects related to the environment or sustainability, and involving members of the UBC student body, will be considered. However, funding requests for projects undertaken as part of coursework at UBC, or individual volunteer projects, must illustrate a connection to the wider student body.
